The North Carolina ArcGIS Users Group (NCAUG) is pleased to announce annual NCAUG Student Scholarship Award application. The scholarships are intended to support full-time students enrolled in GIS-related courses/activities at an accredited North Carolina Community College or University with an emphasis in GIS. Applicants must be enrolled, full-time during the academic year in order to be eligible. Previous NCAUG Scholarship Award recipients are not eligible to apply.

On the application, provide a list of the GIS or Geospatial classes you are currently enrolled in as well as those that you have previously taken and are planning to take.	Provide on the application a brief statement stating your career goals as they relate to the geospatial industry
Provide a digital example of your GIS course work in the form of a map or application that demonstrates your working knowledge of GIS	Provide digitally a poster presentation of your current or proposed research
In two double spaced pages or less discuss the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Why did you find the project (map, application) interesting? 2. What real life applications do you see for this? 	In two double spaced pages or less discuss the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Why did this area of research or inquiry interest you? 2. How would you expand on this particular idea to make an impact in society or to further the knowledge base in this area?
